This Internet Privacy Policy contains information about the gathering and dissemination practices for www.bestcase.com and www.mycaseinfo.com ("the Sites"), the bankruptcy product web sites of Best Case, LLC, a member of the CINgroup family of companies ("Best Case", "We", and "Us"). We reserve the right to change this policy at any time without notice. By visiting the Sites, You ("the visitor") agree to accept all terms and conditions outlined in this privacy policy.

Commitment to Security

Keeping visitors' information secure is very important to us. We employ electronic, physical and procedural safeguards and best practices to protect your information. However, due to the nature of the Internet, we cannot fully guarantee that visitors' information will never be unlawfully intercepted or accessed.

Use of Cookies

Best Case may place Internet "cookies" on visitors' hard drives. Internet cookies may save data about individual visitors, such as the visitor's name, password, user-name, screen preferences, and the pages of a site viewed by the visitor. When the visitor revisits the Sites, the Sites may recognize the visitor by the Internet cookie and customize the visitor's experience accordingly. Visitors may not decline or disable Internet cookies while visiting Sites, as the Sites may not function properly without said cookies. Visitors have the right to delete the Internet cookies placed on the visitors' hard drives at any time. Doing so will erase the data about the individual visitor such that when the visitor revisits the Sites, the Sites will not recognize the visitor.

Collection of Personal Information from Site Visitors

Best Case may collect and/or track (1) the home server domain names, e-mail addresses, type of client computer, and type of Web browser of visitors to the Sites; (2) the e-mail addresses of visitors who communicate with Best Case via e-mail; (3) information knowingly provided by visitors to the Sites in online forms, registration forms, surveys, and contest entries (including demographic and personal profile data such as names, postal addresses, and phone numbers); and (4) aggregate and user-specific information on which pages of the Sites accessed by visitors. Best Case uses this collected personal data for editorial and feedback purposes, for marketing and promotional purposes, for statistical analyses of visitors' behavior, for product development, for content improvement, and/or to customize the content and layout of the Sites. In addition, Best Case may use the collected personal data to contact visitors via calls and mailings regarding updates to the Sites, new products and services, and upcoming events.

Disclosure of Personal Data

Best Case does not sell, rent, share, disclose, or otherwise intentionally make available to non-affiliated third parties any personal data it has collected from visitors, except under the following limited circumstances: (1) the personal data has been fully anonymized and aggregated with data from multiple visitors; (2) the personal data is already publicly available or in the public domain; (3) visitors have knowingly and voluntarily authorized Best Case to disclose the personal data to third parties; and/or (4) the personal data is provided to a third-party mail house contracted by Best Case to conduct a marketing mailing, and said mail house is contractually prohibited from using the data for any other purpose. In the event that Best Case should be requested or required (as by subpoena, civil investigative demand or similar process) to disclose any of the content that is input into, accessed through or maintained or stored in a database related to the Sites to any third party, Best Case will use reasonable efforts to notify visitors, as applicable, so that visitors may seek a protective order or take other appropriate action. Notwithstanding, Best Case shall have no liability to visitors or any third parties for disclosing such content as contemplated by the previous sentence even if visitor was not afforded sufficient time to seek a protective order or other appropriate action.
